

Get Ready for Yet Another Patriot's Super Bowl Win!

The New England Patriots will win the 2018 Super Bowl against the Philadelphia Eagles on Sunday, Feb. 4, at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, Minn. That's my prediction and I'm sticking with it.

This year's game could have been the first time a team competed in the Super Bowl on their home field, The Minnesota Vikings were almost that team since U.S. Bank Stadium is the Vikings' home. However, they lost to the Eagles in the NFC Championship game.

The very First Super Bowl was played on Jan.15, 1967, in Los Angeles between the Green Bay Packers and Kansas City Chiefs. Green Bay defeated the Chiefs then by the score of 35-10. Since then the Patriots have become the winningest team in the Super Bowl era.

The Super Bowl is one of the biggest sporting events viewed around the world the first Sunday of every February. There are about 114.4 Million people who watch the Super Bowl worldwide. There are different performers that sing the national anthem and the performer who will open the Super Bowl by singing the National Anthem this year will be Grammy Award winner Pink. The halftime performer will be Justin Timberlake.
