A small school was created in the basement of a local church because children with intellectual disabilities were not accepted into public schools at that time.

Today, Favarh (pronounced "FAY-var") is a local chapter of the Arc, the world's largest community-based organization for people with intellectual, physical, and developmental disabilities. Favarh supports more than 350 youths, adults, seniors, and families throughout the Greater Farmington Valley area and beyond.

We have more than 330 employees making us the largest employer in Canton. Our 100+ active volunteers work in our Thrift Shop, participate in our Unified Sports Teams, act in our Unified Theater Program, and participate in fundraising efforts. Many of our employees freely choose to volunteer in one or more of these areas demonstrating the level of commitment and dedication to the mission and purpose of the agency.
